# 1. GETTING STARTED

Firstly, make sure your telephone is switched off. If it is not, press and hold the key to switch it off.

#### 1.1 Inserting a SIM card

Remove the battery.

Insert a NanoSIM card as shown on the image.

# 1.2 Inserting the battery

Remove the rear cover.





Position the battery as shown below.



Refit the rear cover.







# 1.3 Charging the telephone

Use the supplied charger to charge the telephone.








Press and hold the key to switch on your telephone.

Use the navigation pad to scroll through the menus.









#### 1.6 Understanding the battery charge level

To view the battery charge level, look at the battery icon in the up right-hand corner.

The telephone will display a message on the screen if the battery charge level is low.

# 2. GENERAL USAGE

#### 2.1 Making a call

To make a call, enter the number you want to call directly on the keypad or select a contact from the **Contact** list.



Use the up and down buttons on the navigation pad to adjust the volume during a call.

#### 2.1.1 Dial a number

To make a call, dial a number and press the key.

When dialing a number, it will appear in the suggestions bar if it has already been saved on your phone.

Use the navigation pad to select the number.






#### 2.1.2 Call a contact









Press the key to call.










# 2.2 Viewing your call history







Select **All calls** to view your full call history.

Then select **Details**.





#### 2.3 Writing a text message





Press the top left key, then select **New chat**.



Type your message.



Enter the number or name of the person you want to text if it is saved in your Contacts list.



Press the selection key **Send** in the men -u.









#### 2.4 Adding a contact






Press the top left key and select **New**.



# 3.1 Choosing a language

### 3.2 Setting a ringtone



From the home screen, press the right-hand section of the navigation pad.

Choose a ringtone from the list and press the top left key to confirm.










#### 3.3 Choosing a wallpaper

# 4. ACCESSIBILITY

#### 4.1 Make texts bigger

You can adjust the text size to be larger.

- 1. Press Menu > Settings > Display > Font size.
- Set the font size from Normal to Big and press OK, then press the top right soft key to save.











# 4.2 Adjust the display brighter

You can adjust the brightness of the display.

- 1. Press Menu > Settings > Display > Brightness.
- Adjust the brightness by using the left and right navigation keys and press the top right soft key when done.
